- Co-op Specialisation major 84 UOC: 48 UOC disciplinary courses plus 36 UOC Industry Training. Must contain at least 18 UOC at level 3. Completion of Industry Placement 3 will also meet Final Year Synthesis program requirements for BCom.
- Free Electives: Students can take up to a maximum of 48 UOC of any course. Students may choose to complete an optional second major/minor using their free electives. General Education: Students must take at least 12 UOC of any General Education course.
- **COMM0999, COMM1999, COMM3999:** myBCom: Students must take all 3 components of myBCom at the specific stages of their program to successfully meet program requirements.
- **NB.** Min/Max Level 1 subjects / Level 2,3 and 4 Maturity Requirements / Excluded courses
